The Cheer Area Representative will be responsible for assisting the Director of Cheer in all aspects of the cheer league. Various duties including oversight of assigned organizations, foster relationships with the organizations points of contact, visit practice locations and/or game days, assist with program budget, provide feedback during regular Cheer Area Rep meetings, and service as an extension for the Florida Elite brand.

Responsibilites:

- Set up and breakdown for all Florida Elite events (i.e., Kick-Off classics, Super Bowl, Pro Bowl, cheer competition, cheer clinics, football clinics, etc.)
- Participate at designated participant certification days
- Conduct all participant check-ins at all Florida Elite's post-season events
- Act as the liaison between Florida Elite Director of Cheer and assigned organization's leadership i.e., President, VP, cheer coordinators and/or coaches
- Build a working relationship with all organizations to ensure the integrity and direction of the organizations cheer program while keeping the Florida Elite brand at the forefront.
- Attend all Florida Elite events
- Game day liaison
- Communicate in a clear concise manner any rule book updates, schedule changes, game day or practice infractions, and organization issues to the Director of Cheer or to the organizations points of contact
- Enforce and uphold the rules and regulations of Florida Elite rule book.
- Travel to designated organization's practice locations and or game days.
- Focus on implementing and instituting the Florida Elite brand and philosophy while serving in a leadership position
- Solicit volunteers for assisting with Florida Elite events
- Accept any and other assigned duties by the Director of Cheer

- Proficient cheer IQ and comprehension of the Florida Elite cheer rulebook
- Able to manage multiple assigned organizations
- Able to communicate in a clear and concise manner to others
- Must be willing to travel to Florida Elite events and to organization locations
